Goalie Will Head Drive for Goodwill

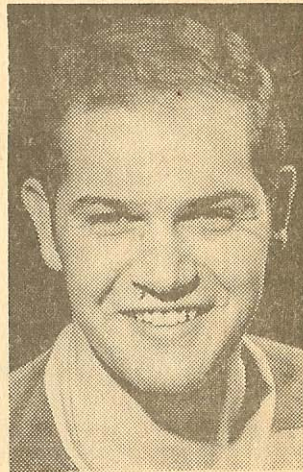
Bob Perani, goalie for the Flint Generals hockey team, has been selected honorary chairman for the Boy Scout clothing drive benefiting Goodwill Industries.

The annual project will be Nov. 6. The processing of materials collected provides training and hours of work for the handicapped employed by Goodwill.

As well as being honorary chairman, Perani also is captain of the G-Team, so called because it will be made up of "guys" (the Boy Scouts), Generals and Goodwill. Perani will marshal a force from 14,000 Boy Scouts in the Tall Pine Council of Genesee, Lapeer and Shiawassee counties.

In October, Perani will conduct hockey clinics at the Goodwill building on S. Averill Avenue for all Scouts who have registered for the G-Team.

He was named to the all-star team of the International Hockey League three times and was voted most valuable player by his teammates twice.
